Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project BSD asked for and received approval to continue data collection activities related to coverage gaps in the State of California, so we continue to collect this data through meetings, conference calls and other requests. The Broadband Services Division conducted governance meetings, such as the CalFRN Board and AT&T/FirstNet PSBN Meetings to discuss the progress of FirstNet deployment in California. BSD utilized broadband conferences to gain more knowledge of emerging and existing broadband technologies, and to network with industry professionals. Individuals of the BSD were also involved in meeting with stakeholders in their respective counties to discuss the FirstNet network capabilities, new local control updates, FirstNet apps, and the AT&T site build out in California. BSD is working on a process to identify public safety users in California. BSD continues to meet with CalSIEC Board members to discuss and plan for future technologies that could be utilized in emergency response. We attend and participate in the CalSIEC's Planning Area Committees in all four regions in California. One member of our team also went to a FirstNet-sponsored Search and Rescue Exercise (SAREX) with Santa Clara County's Sheriff's Office, to watch the event and take notes, using that activity to help plan for other allowable activities; Kristi Mercado From AT&T / FirstNet invited LJ Nielsen to attend this FirstNet event, where FirstNet serivces and devices were handed out and demonstrated to the County Sheriff's department for use in the exercise.

The individuals sent to broadband conferences this quarter are Shelly McMahon, LI Nielsen, Sophia Munoz. Our broadband conferences include the monthly Northern Chapter of APCO, meetings in conjuction with AT&T regarding FirstNet, PSAP meetings, Planning Area Meetings in all four of our regions, etc.
