Additionally, SLIGP Program Manager attended the FirstNet Authority Indiana LMR-LTE Integration Webinar on June 24, 2020 as well as the FirstNet Authority and State of Hawaii 2020 Push to Talk, LMR to LTE Integration Update Webinar in August 2020. The numbers are reflected in item 11, section 2 above however there were no travel costs and/or registration fees charged to the SLIGP budget. (2) Discussion with FirstNet AT&T continued regarding the 30-day Trial Period for Guam's public safety community to utilize the FirstNet devices (mobile and vehicle routers). (3) On September 10, 2020 a conference call with Guam, AT&T and FirstNet Authority took place to receive a Guam Update on the National Public Safety Broadband Network. In September, SLIGP Program Manager held quarterly call with SLIGP Federal Program Officer. (4) Upcoming or planned events for next quarter include the 30-day trial period to begin and follow-up/round table discussion with Guam's Public Safety community.
