Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project (1) SLIGP 2.0 paid for three (3) individuals (SLIGP Program Manager, Guam Fire Department representative and Office of Technology representative) to the IWCE LTE Communications Forum in Chicago, IL from November 6 - 7, 2018. The 2 day forum provided valuable information on emerging communication capabilities; (2) A Guam Public Safety Broadband Workshop with FirstNet was organized and held on November 27, 2018. The workshop invited representatives from Guam's Public Safety Community to create a greater awareness of FirstNet and the services it offers to public safety. Additionally, FirstNet Subject Matter Experts (SME) also went into breakout sessions in the discplines of law enforcement, fire/911, and emergency management. Over 60 public safety community members attended from both Government of Guam and Federal/Military organizations. (3) The contract initiated this quarter was with the Westin Resort Guam for the Guam Public Safety Workshop; (4) Although no SLIGP funds were used, the SLIGP Program Manager participated in the Statewide Communication Interoperability Plan (SCIP) Workshop as well as the Regional Emergency Communications Coordination Workshop Group (RECCWG) in October and November 2018 respectively to provide input on the activities planned for SLIGP and the Nationwide Public Safety Broadband Network. (5) Lastly, Guam held the island's Election for Governor, Lt. Governor, Congress Delegate and Legislature on November 7, 2018. New leadership was sworn in on January 7, 2019. During the visit of FirstNet in November, SLIGP Program Manager spoke with FirstNet Government Affairs representative about organizing a Governance workshop during the first half of 2019 to provide an introduction to FirstNet, the NPSBN and other necessary information to continue planning
