Idaho's contract for a crowdsourcing tool was completed in Q10, but subscribers are slow in . Our focus continues to be remaining in contact with the Governance Boards, Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC), and local Agencies to provide assistance as needed with questions or issues they might have with FirstNet/AT&T. Idaho SLIGP has attended four governance meetings during this quarter, either in person or virtually. Meetings took place in DIGB 2, DIGB 6 and ISPCC. Idaho's SLIGP personnel did not attend any broadband conferences during Q11 in person, but virtually attended the IWCE and various webinars/workshops. Idaho SLIGP will continue attending governance meetings and conferences by any means necessary, to include conference calls, webinars, etc. Idaho SLIGP still plans on viewing/attending the virtual Broadband Conferences/Expo's, Webinars and virtual workshops that we would normally attend. Physical attendance will resume when those Conferences/Expo's become available again and Covid-19 restrictions are lifted. The Pinpoint crowdsourcing application is downloaded on 10 devices with data being tracked by vendor and progress is being tracked and uploaded on ARCGIS mapping.
