Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project Covid-19 protocols continued to impede the day-to-day operations throughout Q12, but we maintained contact with FirstNet, AT&T, local/state governance board members and their constituents. Idaho SLIGP has attended five governance meetings during this quarter, either in person or virtually. Meetings took place in DIGB 3, DIGB 4 (2), DIGB 5, DIGB 6 and the Gem County LEPC. Idaho's SLIGP personnel did not attend any broadband conferences during Q12 in person, but virtually attended the Smart Cities Summit & IOT Security Summit. Idaho SLIGP also attended three FirstNet Webinars during Q12, Healthcare Live, First Responder Network Authority Roadmap, and ECC's and FirstNet. Idaho SLIGP will continue attending governance meetings and conferences by any means necessary, to include conference calls, webinars, etc. according to their schedule. Idaho SLIGP plans to view/attend the virtual Broadband Conferences/Expo's, Webinars and virtual workshops that we would normally attend during the upcoming Q13. Adoption of the Pinpoint crowdsourcing application has not shown any improvement since Q11, due in part to some extra transparency from AT&T and their current coverage maps. Our focus continues to be remaining in contact with the FirstNet Authority personnel, AT&T personnel, Governance Boards, Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC), and local Agencies to provide assistance, as needed, with questions or issues they might encounter.

Idaho will no longer be pursing a contract for Technical Coverage consultant. Pinpoint application works on android devices only which has eliminated many potential participants. Encountering challenges to download and work directly with local stakeholders due to COVID 19 restrictions for face to face meetings. SLIGP Program Manager will reach out to individuals to encourage stakeholder participation in order to accomplish validation of coverage needs/gaps as per the current initial Operational Capability (IOC 3 complete as of 29 Mar 20).
