Idaho SLIGP continued to strengthen the existing working relationships with FirstNet, AT&T, and local/state governance boards to include their constituents. This was accomplished with bi-monthly meetings, regular periodic conference calls
and by attending governance meetings. We routinely provided updates during the Idaho Public Safety Communications Commission (IPSCC) meeting in January and three regional District Interoperability Governance Board (DIGB) meetings during
the quarter. Idaho's SLIGP personnel attended the following broadband conferences; 2 individuals to the Wireless Technical Summit, 9 individuals to the International Wireless Communications Expo (IWCE), one individual to LTE overview
training, and 2 individuals to the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians (ATNI) conference. Idaho sent one individual to meet with the California Office of Emergency Services and California Public Safety Communications / SLIGP. In an effort to
refresh education and gain more FirstNet awareness throughout Idaho, we funded attendance to the IWCE for communication professionals from four of the six Idaho DIGB regions. In Q6, Idaho plans to participate in three (3) broadband
oriented conferences and four (4) or more governance oriented meetings with stakeholders at the state and local level. Planned actions moving forward include specific crowdsourcing efforts in network areas covered by Initial Operational
Capability Period 3. This currently represents the most viable support activity based on NPSBN buildout progress, current adoption rates and anticipated timelines within the state.
