Idaho is working with FirstNet and AT&T to stay current on identifying areas that have been or are being improved with FirstNet/AT&T service. This will allow Idaho to target the appropriate areas with a crowdsourcing tool for State and Local agencies to evaluate and confirm the progress of AT&T's coverage results from IOC2 completion areas as outlined by the FirstNet State Plan. Idaho is planning on implementing the Crowdsourcing tool during this Quarter (Q9). Our focus is now balanced between working with Governance Boards, Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC), and assisting in coverage validation throughout Idaho. We have identified the LEPC's as our best source of new public safety users, as they are predominately attended by actual First Responders. The Idaho SLIGP team attended 5 governance meetings during this quarter. Meetings took place in DIGB 2, 4, 5 and 6, and 1 ISPCC. Idaho's SLIGP personnel attended the following broadband conference; 2 individuals to the Next Gen Wireless Summit. SLIGP personnel (2) also attended the Idaho PSAP Conference and the Idaho Preparedness Conference. In Q9, Idaho plans to participate in two (2) broadband oriented conferences and four (6) or more governance oriented meetings with stakeholders at the state and local level.
