All statutory deliverables due to FirstNet have been completed on time. The Illinois team has a significant amount of Budget remaining and the team is formulating strategies for spending down additional funds. The team is looking at a 5 minute produced video describing future use potential of FirstNet for various disciplines. Outreach continues. We are setting up all our outreach sessions from 2016. The team is transitioning into managing upward within the state. We had a conference call with ether Deputy Governor about FirstNet.
