Match is also provided by the Office of Information Technology Director of Radio Operations who oversees the state radio network (MSCommNet) as well as administrative staff processing payroli and invoices. For 11.1, a governance team meeting held on August 27, 2019. For 11.2, FirstNetME sent project representatives to PSCR in Chicago in July, APCO in Baltimore in August, and to New Hampshire on September 11, 2019 to listen to the national FirstNet representatives at a roadmapping event. For 11.1, a project team members continued outreach efforts as either approved by FirstNet and/or AT&T at the annual meeting of the Telecommunications Association of New England (TANE) and the Convention of Maine Counties, both in September. For 11.11, a project team meeting held on August 26, 2019 during which coverage gap analysis was discussed. Additional activities during the quarter were: FirstNetME conducted a quarterity project review/progress report with AT&T on July 15, 2019 in which national FirstNet and/or AT&T at the AT&T conducted a FirstNet presentation for Maine congressional delegation staff on August 6, 2019; a quarterly call with NTIA staff occurred on August 28, 2019; and a project update was given at the Maine e911 Advisory Council meeting in September. Finally, conversations with stakeholders continued regarding known or perceived gaps in proposed coverage.

(Carryover narrative) The SPOC position is fully funded by this SLIGP 2 grant. Accrued Match for the grant comes from 55% of the Office of Information Technology Director of Communications and Administration. None of this Match was recorded in the Q1 report, so this Q2 report includes both Q1 and Q2 Match. The OIT Director of Communications and Administration ceased providing match in October and was replaced by the OIT Director of Client Technologies beginning in November. The OIT Director of MSCommNet (the state land mobile radio system) had not been included in earlier reports but has been providing match since March. In Section 14 (Budget Worksheet), Indirect expenses previously reported as Approved Matching Funds were erroneously categorized and have been moved to Federal Funds expended. (New narrative) Match now includes time for administrative and financial personnel for time spent processing invoices and assembling end-of-quarter financial information for reporting purposes.
