NC DIT continued to be involved with NPSBN planning. This quarter showed a slow period as NC is working through the procurement process to bring on a consultant in development of data-sharing workshops. NC sent five individuals to the
nternationational Wireless Communications Expo in Las Vegas this past March and one individual to a FirstNet Association meeting. The SIEC (Governance body) met this quarter. Program staff identified potential Public Safety users while
attending various events and meetings with municipal leaders and state agencies. The SPOC position dedicated 24.3% of his work to SLIGP2 activities and the Program Specialist dedicated 22.4%.
