Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project milestones or NC DIT continued to be involved with NPSBN planning for this quarter and had a ramp up in SUGP2.0 activities. This quarter, DIT staff hired a consultant firm to develop content and host data-sharing workshops. NC sent one individual to an event hosted by the Public Safety Broadband Technology Association Regional Forum in Charleston, SC this past May. DIT Staff also funded a member of our governance task force to attend a kickoff meeting with our consulting firm to discuss our datasharing workshops initiative. The SIEC (Governance body) met this quarter. Program staff identified potential Public Safety users while attending various events and meetings with municipal leaders and state agencies. The SPOC position dedicated 11.3% of his work to SUGP2 activities and the Program Specialist dedicated 18.3%. Future work entails holding our pilot datasharing workshop in the month of September as well as reviewing and publishing a website to aid in registation for the data sharing workshops. DIT Staff continues to talk reguarly with consulting firm on the development of the datasharing workshops content and delivery.
