11a. Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project Activities #3 & #8 - Work on a final workshop to be presented to municipal and county administrators commenced in the fourth quarter of 2019 and continued into the first quarter of 2020. Advise was sought and received from the New Jersey League of Municipalities as to content and format. It was determined that attendance of an in-person workshop should be preceded by distribution of a magazine article for New Jersey Municipalities that would introduce the subject. The intent of the article is to expand the knowledge about FirstNet for both public safety primary uses as well as extended primary uses for public service agencies. This article was completed by Mission Critical Partners and submitted for publication March 17, 2020. It was contemplated that the workshop would be held on May 13, 2020 at the Burlington County Public Safety Training Center. The FRNA was contacted for consent to the workshop and to provide a speaker. With the advent of the pandemic it was determined that a webirar would be substituted for the in-person workshop. The webinar was subsequently cancelled due to the demands on local government officials in responding to the pandemic. Other work on the workshop and webinar was cancelled and reversed including the setup and knockdown of the registration portal, development of the agenda and event flyer, and content development.

Activities #9, #10 and #11 - During the quarter, state personnel continued to spend a portion of their time supporting SLIGP activities. Some of these activities included tracking the spending authority in NJ's Comprehensive Financial System for accounting transactions for the SLIGP 2.0 Grant. In addition, a guidelines document for interface to FirstNet from PSAPs was completed in the first quarter. Appointments with the five participating PSAPs are being made in the second quarter to receive feedback and to identify roadblocks to the implementation of advanced services in the PSAP that would be interfaced with FirstNet. An in-person meeting was held on January 24, 2020 with the Atlantic City Police Department to discuss progress in implementation of FirstNet and improvements being made to the PSAP. Additional telephonic meetings with the other four PSAP managers will be held in the second quarter. NJOHSP continued planning for and provided priority updates for the five participating Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP)/911 cell centers in the Phase 2 project, in the PSAPs integration of FirstNet and conducted planning activities centered on technology transitions.
