13b. Narrative description any challenges, updates, or changes related to contracts and/or subrecipients.

We started our stakeholder meetings with the task forces in Pennsylvania during the third quarter of 2018 continuing through the fourth quarter and into 2019. The PA-FirstNet team along with FirstNet and AT&T participated in one meetings in January of 2019 to complete our meetings with Pennsylvania's task force regions. During many of the meetings, valuable interaction between our team, the FirstNet/AT&T team and the stakeholders are occurring; however, during others we have been told that the stakeholders have heard the message multiple times due to AT&T's saturation of marketing to the public safety community. We will continue to engage the community in an effort to discuss any questions and concerns that they may have moving forward as well as to create a governance structure to assist in large scale responses where spectrum resources may be strained. During the first quarter of 2019, the 5th quarter of the grant, planning began for the re-write of the SCIP. Our team is currently working with the Office of Homeland Security, Office of Emergency Communications, Technical Assistance personnel and have garnered support from multiple task force members accross the Commonwealth.
