Governor of Wyoming - Matt Mead, opt-ed Wyoming into FirstNet July 10, 2017. Wyoming became the 2nd state to accept the State plan and opt-in. During the Eclipse, Wyoming was the first state to have FirstNet services purchased and functioning for an event. Casper PD and Teton County purchased mobile hot spots for additional capacity and coverage. Troy Babbitt -Telecommunications Program Manager at WYDOT was the WY SPOC for the entire SLIGP 1.0 time frame. He also became the SWIC, with the retirement of Bob Symons, Sept 2017. Note: OVERMATCH: state hours exceeded match and were no longer be recored for match, based on number of hours contributed. Personal Salaries [a.] and Personnel Fringe Benefits (b.) have maxed out at \$30,000 and \$10,000 repectively. Une item was zeroed (0) out. SLIGP 2.0 application was submitted Dec 21, 2017 and awarded March 28, 2018. There were 1274 Wyoming stakeholders recorded over the SLIGP 1.0 time period. These stateholders were engaged in many different ways. Many attended the Governors annual Broadband Summits, where FirstNet presented. The project was also updated at every PSCC (Public Safety Communications Please describe in detail any SLIGP program priority areas (education and outreach, governance, etc.) that you plan to continue beyond the SLIGP period of performance.

Outreach and education will continue beyond the SLIGP period of performance. Any statewide Emergency Communications meetings held will address FirstNet. This will include the concept, status, tower buildout, subscriptions, coverage area, any and all activities.
