This is the Final PPR for SUGP 1.0. No funds were utilized for this final quarter. All remaining funds are to be de-obligated back to NTIA. Even though no funds were used, Wyoming continues to promote and educate statewide stakeholders of FirstNet activities and progress. This includes updates the the Wyoming PSCC (Public Safety Communications Commission) and other state/county/city meetings. Governor of Wyoming - Matt Mead, opt-ed Wyoming into FirstNet July 10, 2017. Wyoming became the 2nd state to accept the State plan and opt-in. Wyoming was the first state to have FirstNet purchased and functioning for an event (Solar Eclipse fall 2017). Park County has purchased mobile hot spots for additional capacity and coverage. Troy Babbltt -Telecommunications Program Manager at WYDOT remains as WY SPOC and now also the SWIC. Note: OVERMATCH: state hours have exceeded match and will no longer be recored for match, based on number of hours contributed. Personal Salaries (a.) and Personnel Fringe Benefits (b.) have maxed out at \$30,000 and \$10,000 repectively. Line item 61 has been zeroed (0) out. SLIGP 2.0 application was submitted and awarded Mar 28, 2018.

WYDOT is in charge of the State of Wyoming's – PSCC (Public Safety Communications Commission) meetings and give FirstNet updates. There were no meetings held before Feb 28th. We have installed dual band Cradle Point modems in 2 Wyoming Highway Patrol vehicles to collect coverage data. Information is being analyed and shared for coverage gaps in Wyoming.

We have created a FirstNet for Wyoming. Goosle + community, as a single point of information reference for our statewide emergency responders. Participate in the Western States collaboration and meetings because of similar rural issues. 11b. Wyoming had no changes for the quarter.

The State of Wyoming is now working with CASM and OEC. Along with the CASM tool, the state is continuing Google mapping training. Mapping with Google Earth is being utilized for the Public Safety environment. Outreach is also being accomplished, without having to spend funds from the SLIGP grant. It is being mentioned and discussed in statewide public safety association meetings.

The SPOC is also, now the SWIC and continues building statewide relationships and networking/communication skills to the project. While Wyoming's small population and large geographic areas will cause challenges in future coverage areas, it is currently an asset for outreach to stakeholders statewide. This position continue to leverage relationships, with a champion for this cause and using this ability to reach out quickly to state/city/county contacts. We continue to provide information about SLIGP at these meetings and want members to be engaged with the grant program. We have had meetings with our state financial team in closing out SLIGP 1.0 and addressing SLIGP 2.0.
