Hi

I work for a large non-profit hospital. here is my input.

Allow wireless (3g-4g) data to be sold to hospitals at cost. Wireless data is important for home health nurses who visit patients in remote areas of the country, and the only access is cellular data. The cost for a hospital to use this should be minimal.

We also use 3g cellular data for mobile clinics, again the cost should be minimal.

We also would like to use 3g wireless for backups links to small remote offices. This would provide network redundancy for small clinics. . .it would provide similar service as the multiple carrier redundancy that we have in the larger hospitals.

I suggest that the government should find a way to make 3G cellular data more affordable for hospitals (and police/fire).
