Envirnomental assessments have started with all off-site work just getting started. An RFQ for sureyor work is currently released with responses due Friday April 14, 2023, Subrecipient Upward Broadband - We have completed all of the agreements and amendments between the recipient and sub-recipients. We have been continuing to sign land agreements for lease, and or sale. All of the descoping and related budgets, maps, documents, etc. have been completed.

There were delays in getting all of the agreements and amendments signed by each party. Some negotiations with landowners at proposed tower sites have stalled or falled, causing us to find other sites and begin negotiations again. Some urnover of staff members, both at ABI and Upward have proven challenging and time consuming.

All draft environmental assessments have been completed and submitted to NTIA. Segments 1-8 are in the process of finalizing the FONSI for all sites. Segment 9 is in the process of acquiring and submitting additional environmental information. For segments 1-8, land agreements for lease, and or, sale have been progressing steadily and there are only two more left to finalize. Upward has filled several open positions within our company, such as a staff accountant and a compliance specialist, who will be able to help drive progress on this project. For Segment 9, draft lease agreements have been shared with the property owners and we are waiting responses.

Please describe any challenges to achieving project accomplishments during this reporting period funded through BIP grant. (600 words or less)

The grant receipient, Huntingdon County, has recently become aware that 4 towers that were originally planned to provide coverage for Huntingdon County residents have been moved, due to various reasons. These four towers will no longer provide broadband coverage for Huntingdon County residents which significantly impacts the County's ability to contribute match funds for that portion of the project. The subrecipient, Upward Broadband, is also unable to contribute additional match funds to the project and there is currently a gap that needs to be filled to ensure that matching funds are available for the entire project. NTIA has therefore placed on hold the affected segments until this matter can be resolved.
