A Request for Qualifications was posted for Engineering and Design, and a company was selected to complete the process of Engineering, Design and Environmental. Work is beginning on engineering and is expected to take 10 months. The Broadband Manager is currently working with the

	CN Grants and Accounting office to revise the budget, as some funds will be shifted into construction from engineering and design.
