I receive my television signal over the air using an antenna in my attic and a 19????????? analog only TV, I do

not have cable or satellite service. I applied on Jan. 2, 2008 for 2 coupons in 2 separate requests, one

for my physical address which does not have a mailbox, but forwards to my PO Box and one with my

PO box address. Both requests clearly indicated my true and correct physical residential address.

have yet to receive either coupon. Since making my requests I have learned that the coupons would

be sent standard mail, which is not forwarded by the Post Office, so my coupon request to be sent to

my physical address will probably never be delivered. The other request to be sent to my PO Box will

also probably not be delivered because I chose to use a PO Box for delivery. My reasons for

using a

PO Box for the past 10 years are several, including identity theft. Online checking of my request

confirmation numbers showed that my requests were both approved. When I called the 888 inquiry

number between 9-5 on a weekday last week, I received ????????no one????????s available, call again later????????. If and

when my coupons show up, which I doubt, I expect they will have expired.

I respect the Government???????s concern about fraud, but for me, this change to Digital offers little benefit

and lots of inconvenience. Please revise the rules on PO Boxes, lift the expiration date, or at least

extend it to a year, and send the coupons ???????forwarding guaranteed????????.
