All residents of facilities who have their own television see should be able to apply and receive TV Converter Box Coupons at the facility they reside in. These residents may be of any age and live any facility (nursing home, assisted living, state school, group home, etc.).

Residents or their legally authorized representative should apply, and they should be able to use their name and address like all other citizens do. They should not have to provide a Social Security number or date of birth. The process should not be any different for them.

The coupons applied for should be for personal use and notifior the use of the facility
