

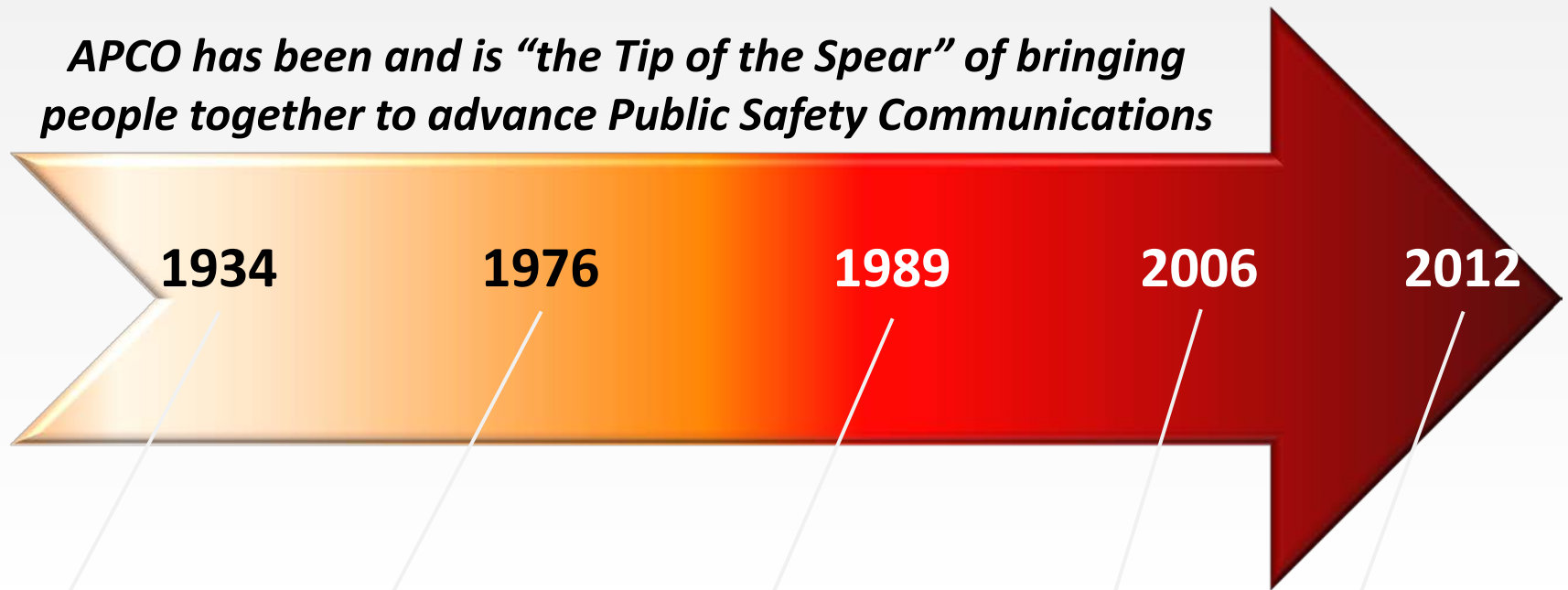

APCO Created

FirstNet Created

APCO 16 Initiated

- Establish basic requirements for a typical public safety communications system.
- Non-technical standard to which many manufacturers have responded.

APCO 25 Initiated

- Open standard for digital radio developed in North American.
- Standard was developed to foster the development of digital public safety communications.

APCO 25/34 Initiated

- User-driven process to establish communications requirements of the public safety community.
- Develop, with direct involvement of both users, manufacturers and TIA an evolving suite of technical standards....

9/11 CREATED AWARENESS FOR A NATIONWIDE PUBLIC SAFETY NETWORK



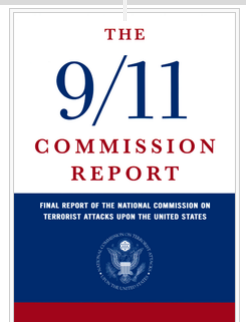

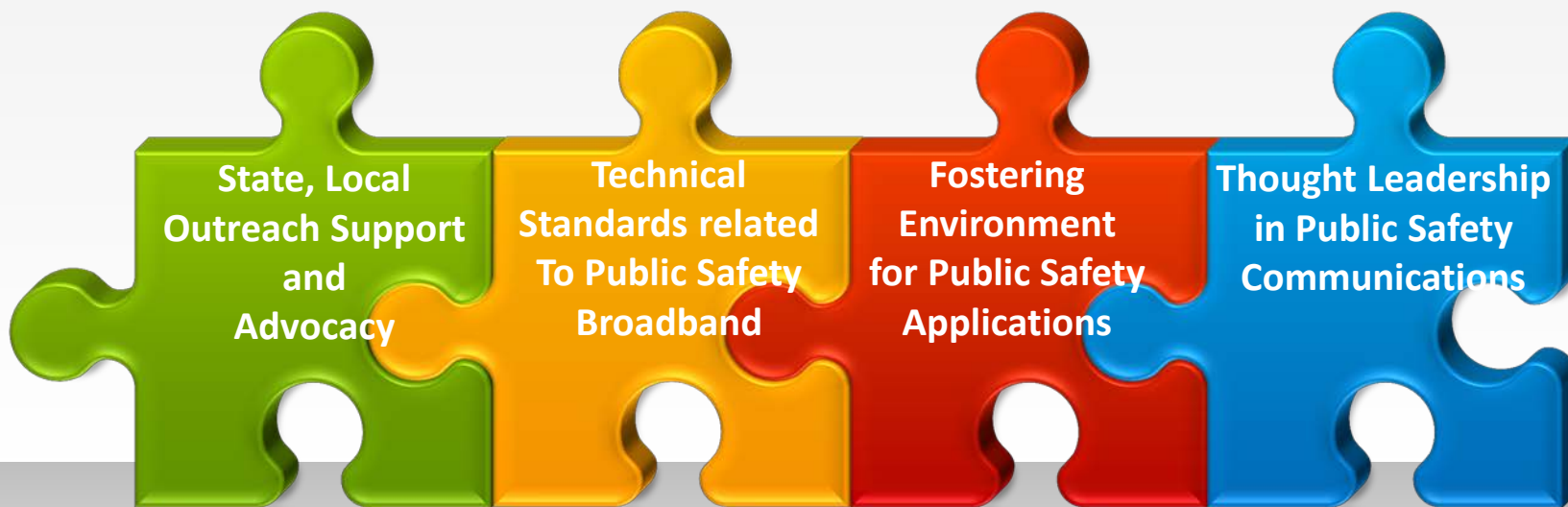

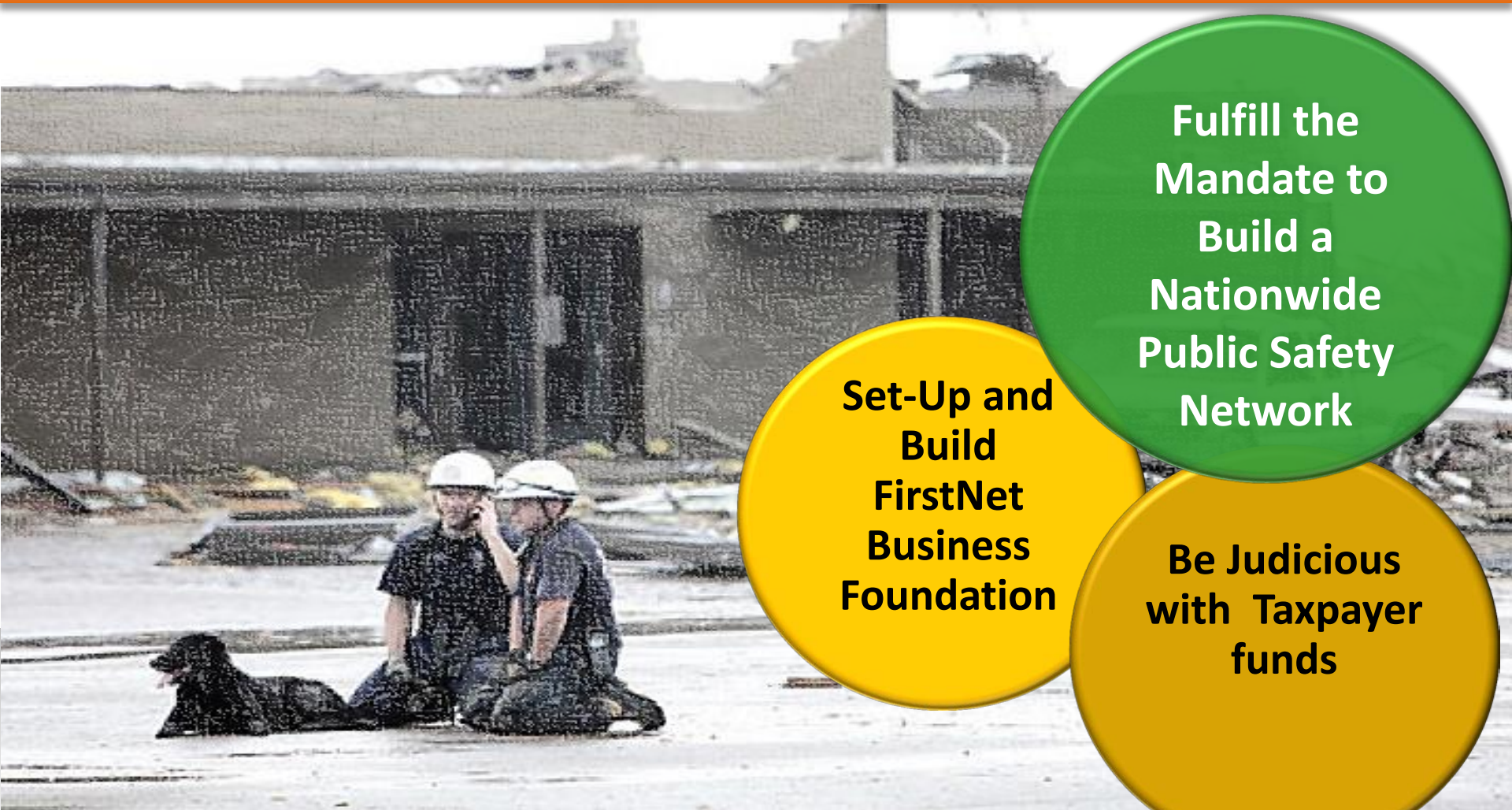
