## 7. **REVISED - Period of Performance and Funding Limitations:**

The scope of work and budget incorporated into this award cover the period from 03/01/2018 to 02/29/2020 (referred to as the "project period"), for a total of \$700,000.00 in Federal funds. NIST acknowledges receipt of the Recipient's request dated 09/26/2019 to extend the project period by 13 months at no additional cost to the Federal government.
