Comments from Korean governments(Ministry of Science and ICT)

- 2. The Korean government is partially supporting the R&D budget for Open-RAN and is considering various measures to boost private cooperation.
- 23. In order to promote teaming, it is necessary to expand the funding target not only to US companies but also to non-US companies that want to cooperate in Open-RAN.
- 25.a. Enabling countries other than the United States to benefit will help the global spread of Open-RAN. 25.b. Even for companies that are not headquartered in the United States, supporting companies willing to cooperate on Open-RAN will help the global spread of Open-RAN.
- 25.c. It is also necessary to review relaxed regulations on products produced by companies in countries that have global partnerships with the United States on Open-RAN for the spread of Open-RAN.
- 26. It is necessary to specify a cooperation plan with the government.
